Basic Playground Rules

No Play Zones

- 1. Far side of all buildings
- 2. The corner by Green 2. (must be to the left of red sign)
- 3. Inside any building or room without supervision
- 4. The play structure for the 6th through 8th graders.

Playground

1. Play structure:

Slide use. On your bottom, feet first. No stopping and no climbing. No feet where hands go. No climbing on exterior.

2. Lawn:

Soccer and Football are allowed but the ball cannot go over the fence more than twice. Balls may be retrieved by 2 students, 4th grade and up.

- Tetherball: No climbing poles.
- Basketball: No hanging on rims.

Personal Items During Recess

Permitted items:

Basketballs, footballs, soccer balls or other balls over 4 inches in diameter.

Conditionally permitted:

Writing, drawing and knitting instruments. These must be used while sitting on benches. Yo-yos for 6th grade and older.

Not permitted:

Tennis or golf balls or balls under 4 inch diameter. Toys.

Lunch Recess Discipline:

During lunch, we emphasize the ideals we're teaching the children within the Safe and Caring Schools Program, the "golden rule" and "problem solving" in particular. If necessary, age-appropriate applications of our School Discipline Policy will be administered as well.
