Tuition

Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of each month beginning August 1, 2025 and continuing through May 1, 2026. A \$25.00 late fee per child will be imposed on all tuition received and receipted after 3:30pm of the due date. If the 1st of the month falls on a weekend, legal holiday, or school recess, the due date will then be the next school day. If tuition is not paid by 3:00pm on the 10th of the month, your child will not be allowed to attend Preschool. Failure to pay will result in your child's account being sent to collections. Re-admittance to the program is on a space available basis only and will require payment of account balance in full plus an additional \$50.00 re-registration fee.
